Maths Challenge



This is a similar problem to last week. This week you need to add 4 numbers along the longer sides and 3 numbers down the shorter sides of a rectangle. All sides must add up to 20. You can use any whole numbers. I'll start you with 4 in the bottom left hand corner and a 9 in the bottom right hand corner. Put the number 14 in one of the top middle numbers. How many ways can you find? Answer next week.

Answer to Triangle numbers:

One answer is 5 at the apex with 6, 8,1 down one side, 4,2 and 9 down the other with 3 and 7 filling in between the 1 and 9.
