Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our Space topic, we are going to visit the Science Museum in London on 21st November 2019. We will be leaving the school at 8.30am sharp. We would ask that you ensure that your child arrives at school for 8:05am that day and comes straight into the classroom.

The cost of the trip is £22.70. This includes transport, exciting hands on exhibits and workshops, as well as an IMAX cinema experience. Please ensure that you complete the permission form in Parentmail return your payment, by 24th October.

To make this visit financially viable we ask for a voluntary contribution from parents. This contribution would be equal to the cost of the activity. If parents cannot make the full contribution due to financial restraints please contact the school Business Manager or Head teacher in strictest confidence. Please do not assume your child would not be able to go if you are unable to pay the full amount requested.

However, if sufficient parents were unable to contribute the visit may not go ahead.

We will be returning at approximately 4.00pm so you can pick your children up from the playground (if the traffic is poor we may be slightly late, we will notify the office if this is the case so the message can be passed out to the playground).

For this trip the children will need:

- A packed lunch in a light bag and water bottle. All named. Children will need to carry their lunch.
- A coat
- Comfortable shoes as we will be walking around the Museum (there is an outside area)
- School uniform
- Any travel sickness bags (if your child suffers from travel sickness we ask that any medication be taken before the start of the school day, thank you.)
- £3 for the shop
