

Maths

This term, we will begin to look at addition and subtraction, multiplication, division and area.

There will continue to be a focus on reasoning, fluency and problem solving.

We will be using and applying our maths skills and knowledge and making connections. It is important your child learns their times tables up to 12 x 12 where possible.

Science

We will be starting the new topic of Electricity.

In the second half of the term the children will learn about Sound how it travels and how we can muffle sound.

English

In English this term we will be looking at text, The village that vanished.

In response to this texts the children will have opportunities to produce a non-fiction fact page write poems and narrative.

Religious Education

In our RE lessons we will focus on **In-carnation** - What is the Trinity? (Digging Deeper) and **Islam** - Prophethood. Why do Muslims call Muhammad the 'seal of the prophets?'

Geography

We will be delving in to the heart of Africa. We will be looking at this varied

continent making comparisons between countries in Africa and our own, looking at the amazing landscapes and learning about different aspects of culture.

Art and Design Technology

The focus in our African topic will engage children in sketching, designing and painting a Savannah scene and encompassing stitching within it.
